WHAT WILL YOU DO IN ASHEVILLE?

This April, the mission is clear: share the Gospel in WORD and DEED. Each day, we will focus on a different area of the city and share the Gospel through evangelism in the morning. Then we will demonstrate the Gospel with an extreme act of love, like a home makeover in the afternoon. Will you join us in Asheville, NC?

ABOUT ASHEVILLE, NC

Asheville can be described as a combination of Austin, TX and Sedona, AZ. It is a little weird with a New Age flare. However, you cannot overlook the southern feel in this amazingly quaint town. Settled in the Blue Ridge Mountains of North Carolina, Asheville is comprised of an eclectic 73,000 people. Walking down the streets of downtown, you will hear live music, watch artists paint, maybe see a living statue, and probably experience something that is just a little weird. That is because the people of Asheville are open to just about anything. You are always able to find a good meal, an interesting shop and someone who will want to talk. It is a town that revels in its sin, but desperately needs Jesus. However, God has His people in Asheville and they are strong, prayerful, and expecting Him to move!

WHO SHOULD GO TO ASHEVILLE WITH TIME TO REVIVE?

Anyone who loves Jesus Christ and desires to see Him exalted in Asheville should come. Of course, you need to be healthy enough to travel and walk a little, but if God is calling you to go, He has something for you to do in Asheville for His glory! We do not have an age limit and encourage families to be involved!

WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

TRAVEL INFORMATION

The only costs you would incur are the cost of travel to/from Asheville and any incidentals you may have. Time to Revive is providing your food, accommodation (in local homes), and supplies.

CAN! COME FOR JUST A FEW DAYS?

Of course! If you are not able to be in Asheville from April 16-22, then only come on the days you are available.

- **-Weather** The weather in Asheville for late April is usually warm in the afternoon and cold in the evenings. The average highs are in the mid-to-upper 60s and the average lows are in the mid-to-upper 40s. Of course, bring sunscreen for sunny days and a rain jacket or poncho for wet days, but you will probably need a warm coat.
- -Clothing You will be given a reviveASHEVILLE T-shirt, so anticipate wearing clothing under it in layers if you tend to be cold. Asheville can be cold in April; however, you will probably spend a great deal of time on your feet causing you to feel warmer. Be

sure to wear comfortable shoes for walking long distances. Jeans are acceptable almost at all times. Slacks/skirts are generally worn only at church or other formal events. Remember to bring a backpack or something to carry a water bottle, or other belongings and to keep them near you at all times.

- **-Food** & **Money** We will do our best to provide you with adequate meals and snacks during your reviveASHEVILLE experience. On most days, you will need money to purchase snacks and one meal a day.
- **-Local Shopping** Asheville is a tourist city and offers many shopping opportunities. There is a local Target, Walmart, pharmacies etc. if you forget something, but downtown Asheville has unique shops and gifts for just about any taste.
- -Airport Asheville Regional Airport (AVL) is located in Asheville. Round-trip airfare from DFW to AVL is approximately \$330 when booked ahead of time. As always, you may find difficulty purchasing tickets at the last minute within your price range. reviveASHEVILLE will be providing regular shuttle services from the airport. The next nearest airport is GSP International Airport (GSP). reviveASHEVILLE will NOT be providing shuttle services to GSP.

As a result of the decades of prayer for the city, the time is now and God is moving in Asheville.
